As a mature student she enrolled at St. Mary's University, Halifax and graduated with a degree in Religious Studies. Her work history is as follows: Graduating from Holland College, she spent time as a reporter with newspapers in Truro, NS, Moncton, NB and the Cape Breton Post, Sydney. Moving to Toronto, she became Managing Editor of Canada's National Catholic Newspaper, The Register. Returning to Sydney, she was Director of Annulments for the Diocese of Antigonish. She was employed there for 20 years retiring 4 years ago. Elizabeth was an avid reader and loved to travel, travelling across Canada and parts of Europe.
