With profound sadness, we announce the peaceful passing of Flossie (Falconer) Robertson on January 13, 2021. Born in Sydney, NS, on August 19, 1921, Flossie was the daughter of the late Thomas Falconer and Eliza (Burge) of Franklin Street, Whitney Pier. Her parents immigrated from Bonavista, Colony of Newfoundland in 1910. She was the 7th child of 9 children born into a kind and generous Salvation Army household. Flossie was predeceased by all her siblings: William Jobe "Joe" (Else), Benaiah "Ben" (Annie Currie), Amos (Catherine), Pearl (Jack McCann), Amelia "Minnie" (George Nichol), Violet (Earl Wilson), Leroy "Roy" (Mary McInnis) and Blanche (Norman Burton).
